Introduction

CPclean is the Check Point clean up utility for Window's platforms.

What's new in CPclean build number 54001

- Clean all products, leaves only Check Point UserAuthority and Check Point Session Authentication
- Clean kernel files
- Clean services
- Clean registry
- Clean files and directories

Platforms

CPclean operates on Windows XP, Windows 2000, Windows ME, Windows NT and Windows 98.

Using CPclean

- 1 Download** the package to temporary directory.
- 2 Open** the compressed package.
- 3 Run** setup.exe.

CPclean works like a standard Check Point installation, it displays a few screens that show you elements that will be deleted, you confirm the actual clean-up operation and it recommends rebooting.

- 4** You can find a log file with the list of all deleted elements and elements that could not be deleted in %SystemRoot%\cpclean.log.
